In Hungary we were introduced to a new grouping of churches ... and were blessed to experience the different aspects of the Body of Messiah from a small country church to the vibrant City church.

We also met with and ministered in an inner city (Budapest) congregation where the church has a very prophetic calling, Not only was their church building a place where kings were ordained, but is also the site of a nunnery where a Sister worked to save many Jews during WWII¹.

Our time in Hawaii was very special. This was the first **true** Body ministry that we have seen functioning to the severely wounded and broken people whom God has assigned to them.

All of their leadership is fully focused and committed towards one goal – and that is being the family of ABBA Father – creating a **safe place** to heal and restore.

The leaders are mature – they themselves have worked through deep levels of inner healing and deliverance for a number of years – they have each other's backs and stand as **one** army of Almighty God against the attacks of satan and his army.

We were treated with such respect and dignity – every day was an experience to see what surprises they had for us! The food, coffee and many treats were amazing!

We had TWO trips to the Netherlands this past year. In **March** we taught on spiritual warfare, covering the area of altars. They have quite a number of Houses of Prayer across the nation – and it was such a blessing to hear the feedback from so many groups as they applied this teaching in prayer for their cities and families.

In **November**, we again taught in Utrecht – covering the Believer's Warfare in the Heavens and keeping in step with God's Times and Seasons. It was such a blessing to have Roly join us on his first ministry trip to the NL – there was truly such a sense of spiritual covering for the team – and so many men were very happy to meet him!

We were also blessed to be able to minister on bloodline issues in a Messianic congregation building in The Hague. We had a large crowd sign up – and we are excited to report that Kanaan Ministries, Netherlands, is growing!! We interacted with members from a number of Dutch congregations and were blessed to see that the ministry of compassion and mercy as well as counselling is thriving. We also had the privilege to minister one morning service in Rotterdam just before we came home.

They also use the opportunity to train other counsellors who come with their clients from overseas.

In between the ministry trips, we also managed to book a trip to Israel – our time was spent at the Galilee, Ein Gedi and Jerusalem. We visited some new places and walked another wadi (dry river bed). It was such a blessing to be there again at one of the Feasts – Shavuot / Pentecost.

God moved in many ways – we had many precious moments – what stood out for us was that God impressed on our hearts that we should be ready to act “suddenly”.

From the old city ruins and the city of Susita in the North - to the Wadi's in the South - we were blessed.

Next year in Jerusalem!!!! May the streets of that City be filled with Joy.

On a personal note:

As many of you know - we relocated a year ago to a small town along the Garden Route – about 5 hours drive from Cape Town. We are so happy here – out of the rat-race from the busy city of Cape Town.

We take long walks on the beach and love the sound of the waves. We had a show of whales during the winter months and had the joy of seeing mothers swimming with their calves after giving birth in our bay.

We have a show of dolphins every day as well as the usual sea life. Every day we wake up with a sense of deep joy and gratefulness – expecting ABBA Father to speak as we rejoice in the LIFE He has given to us.
